Visit the fortifications (ramparts, moats, the Lunette d'Arçon tower and its underground passage).
The 360° views of the surrounding peaks.
The craft workshops and cheese maturing cellar housed in two of the barracks.

This stronghold listed by UNESCO as a Vauban fortification, a remarkable defensive complex built in 1692 to secure the Alpine border, is well worth a visit.

A unique visit at the heart of a spectacular landscape. Bring your groups to the Rochambeau barracks to visit the exhibition on Little Bighorn, the last Indian victory sculpted by Ousmane Sow and comprising 11 horses and 24 figures, including the main chiefs Sitting Bull, Crazy Horse, Two Moon and Chief Gall, who are depicted facing off against General Custer's troops.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The site is named after the Grand Dauphin, the King's eldest son.
